

RACE AS A SOCIAL PRINCIPLE OF VISION AND DIVISION.

Inspired by Bachelard, Weber and Bourdieu, I sketch a framework for rethinking "race" as a principle of classification and stratification. I highlight its generic properties, common with other forms of human division, and its specific features, including the correspondence it establishes between culture and nature. Drawing on my book RACIAL DOMINATION (2024), I provide illustrations from around the world to flesh out the heuristic value of the framework.
